

Supplement questions for Lesson 5 *Like No Other: A Death Like No Other.*

In his message, Pastor Christian talked about images and examples that explain how Jesus's saving actions affect us. Read the passages below and discuss: How does this image help us understand God's love for us? How does this idea connect Jesus's death to our deaths?

Colossians 2.11-15; Hebrews 2.14-18; Hebrews 9.11-14

Read Romans 6-8. Why do you think Paul includes the line, "while we were sinners"? What makes that important?

Read John 3.16-17. What part is the hardest to understand? What questions arise as you read it? Is there a part of the world (location, people group, etc.) you need to grow in love for?

John 15.12-17 describes Jesus's commandment to love. Where have you seen this type of love exhibited?

Jesus's death is the cornerstone of the Gospel. Without the death, there is no good news. In your own words, why do people find the gospel message offensive?
