

Supplement questions for *Like No Other: A Resurrection Like No Other*.

When have you experienced a great, unexpected surprise?
How does our expectation of event change how we experience it?

What were the women expecting to find when they went to the tomb early in the morning?

John 20 gives the account of Peter and John seeing the empty tomb. Read John 20.1-10. What did the disciples believe (v. 8)? How did the empty tomb not match their expectations?

How does Jesus meet or not meet your expectations?
What are some ways to develop correct expectations of Jesus?

Read John 20.24-29. Do you resonate with Thomas? Have you been held back from believing in the resurrection like Thomas? What stops you from believing? What helps us overcome our disbelief?

Why do you think the mention of fear in this story is important? What positive and negative things does fear do in our lives?

The disciples live with less fear after the encounter the risen Jesus. Can you think of other stories about the disciples that highlight their change?

Has an encounter with the risen Jesus changed how you live? How can the resurrection change our day-to-day lives?
