3. Read James 2:14–18. James reminds his readers to respond to faith with action. Where in your life is God, through the Holy Spirit, drawing you to action?
4. Referencing James 5:13–20, what are some things we are invited to do because of our faith in Christ? How can we support one another?

Live it Out
