REFLECT ON SUNDAY'S SERMON

- What resonated with you from the message this week?
- Did it bring up anything you're wrestling with or questions you have?

READ & DISCUSS

- Read Proverbs 13:24 and Psalm 23:5. The rod is a tool for guidance and protection and it is not meant as a weapon. How have you seen this proverb misused in discipline?
- How do you see Jesus focusing on the spiritual character formation of those he encounters rather than behavior modification? Use your Bibles together to find examples.
- What spiritual character trait do you hope others see in and learn from you? Why?
- Read Ephesians 6:4 and 4:32 What can we learn from these passages about how we should lay down guardrails for the next generation?
- When and how have you found guardrails to be helpful? Is there an area of your life in which establishing guardrails would be beneficial?

LIVE IT OUT

- Where are the areas of your life that you have the opportunity to speak into the lives of the next generation?
- As we close this series, what is your takeaway for raising the next generation of the church? Make a list of key things you would like to do to encourage the next generations at Shepherd of the Valley.
